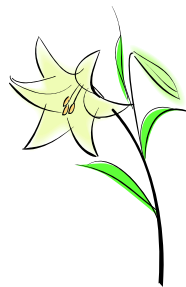

China Green with Jasmine

A traditional Chinese tea that dates back to the Song Dynasty in the 9th Century. Jasmine flowers are plucked around noon, when the blossoms are most tightly closed. They are added to the tea in the evening as they start to open and release their full fragrance.

Chamomile

Premium Chamomile flowers from Egypt are dried quickly after being plucked to preserve their mild, fresh flavour. .

Earl Grey

Charles Grey, an English Earl is given credit for this soothing tea. It is blended with natural oil from Bergamot and is believed to keep the mind, body and spirit in harmony.
